This 8- hour class blends NFPA 1670 operational skills for swiftwater rescue, surface water rescue, and technical small animal rescue for application in a flood response. The class will also meet the criteria for FEMA Resource Typing Swiftwater/Flood Search & Rescue Technician-Animal Rescue Specialist. The class will start with a 3-hour classroom session to cover all the topics required and then break for an early lunch and meet at the field location. The rest of the afternoon will be field practical's and rescue scenarios. The focus on the class will be small animal applications but we will discuss in length large animal scenarios as it seems to be more and more common. PREREQUISITES: Participants must show proof of current Swiftwater Technician certification from their agency or Training Officer. Participating agencies will need to provide their own PPE and are encouraged to bring their boats to use in
