Course Description

This class is limited to 30 participants.

This customized combination training hits many topics needed for Type 1 ASAR teams. Training is provided through both hands-on and classroom instruction with primarily a small animal focus. Attendees must have working knowledge of low angle ropes, knots, anchors, and mechanical advantage. Instructors will review low angle ropes briefly and then quickly into high angle rope rescue considerations. In addition, we will be adding the ASAR introduction to collapsed structure and confined space into this 6-day training. Participants will need to provide proper PPE for this training (see list below).
